Dr. Sattler received her Bachelor of Science Degree in mathematics, her M.Ed. in post-secondary mathematics and her Ph.D. in higher education with minors in research and measurement and educational technology from the University of Toledo.

She has worked for Terra Community College since 1982. She began as an adjunct mathematics instruction and was hired as a full-time instruction in 1988. In 1989, she became head of the Mathematics and Science Department. She has held various positions at the college and now serves as Dean of Arts & Sciences and Business at Terra and continues to teach mathematics online as an adjunct faculty member. She also teaches math education classes online for Walden University in their masters program.

Dr. Sattler is a member of AMATYC (American Mathematical Association of Two Year Colleges) and has served as chair of the Placement & Assessment Committee and the Distance Learning Committee. She is presently serving as Treasurer of the organization. She has also served on the Mathematical Sciences Education Board.
